



# DR. VIJAY P. JAYADE THE HUBBALLI'S 'HERITAGE'!

Dr. Vijay Jayade was born on June 3rd, 1941 in a small village Kanakumbi, which is situated in the Belagavi District, Karnataka. As he grew up, he pursued his primary and secondary education in Hubballi. He completed his primary school education from Marathi boys' school and secondary school education from The New English School. Born to Shri Pandurang Vishnu Jayade and Shrimati Kamla Pandurang Jayade, he was always an obedient child. Unfortunately, he lost his mother when he was three years old. He was ably taken care of then by his second mother, Smt. Shantabai Pandurang Jayade. He had a brother Ravindra and a sister Vidya (both unfortunately are no more). Dr. Jayade did his first year Science study in Karnataka College, Dharwad, and his Inter Science from Fergusson college, Pune.



#### His 'Dental' Dream...

For choosing Dentistry as his life, the whole credit goes to his father, who was a Doctor (Ayurveda practitioner) and

trained under a qualified dental surgeon. His father subsequently developed his own technique of extracting teeth without anesthesia, based on Yogic principles. He went to America to give lectures on his unique technique. He stayed as an observer in Georgetown University where he saw the scope of Modern Dentistry. On returning, he inspired both his sons to pursue Dental studies.



Dr. Vijay Jayade started his BDS from C.E.M. Dental College (the Precursor of GDC) Mumbai. When he entered the second year, the college was shifted to a new building, that was named as the Government Dental College. He finished his bachelor's degree in the year 1965. He went on to do his MDS in Orthodontics from GDC Mumbai from the year 1965 to 1967.

He started his practice in Hubli in the year 1968, initially as general Dental practice, since there was zero awareness for Orthodontics in his region. He was the only Orthodontist between Pune and Bangalore at



that time. Still, he had to wait for quite some time for his first orthodontic patient. Thereafter, his Orthodontic practice started to pick up.

In the year 1988, he joined the KLE Dental College, Belgaum as a teacher and then after a year, he shifted to the SDM Dental College, Dharwad. He continued to serve the institution for a long time as the Professor and HOD. At the age of 65, he retired from the Institution in the year 2005. Subsequently, he worked as Professor Emeritus at Sibar Dental College (Guntur—Andhra Pradesh) for five years till the age of 70.

#### Family comes first...



He married Smt. Anuradha on May 17th, 1968. She was a great life partner and an avid homemaker. The couple was blessed with two sons – Bhushan and Chetan. The elder son, Dr. Bhushan Jayade, is an Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeon who is happily living in Dubai with his wife Dr. Gouri (dental surgeon). They have two sons – Shreyas and Rohit.

The younger son, Dr. Chetan Jayade (a well-known name in Indian Orthodontic Society), is an Orthodontist and is happily married to Dr. Hema (a dental surgeon), and have a son – Nishant and a daughter – Anika.

#### Work is Worship...

During his MDS journey, his teachers were Dr. H.S. Shaikh and Dr. Prem Prakash. Both of them were instrumental in initiating Begg's technique in GDC, Mumbai. Dr. Jayade felt that

he needed advanced training to acquire greater proficiency. Hence, he took two courses: a basic course in the year 1976 and an advanced course in the year 1982 at the Kesling & Rocky Centre, Westville Indiana (USA). Additionally, he had the good fortune of meeting and learning from stalwarts like Dr. Swain, Dr. Harry Barrer, Dr. Sidney Brandt, Dr. Bill Thomson and Dr T. M Graber during these visits.

Dr. Barry Mollenheuer was a guest speaker at Hyderabad Conference in the year 1992, whose innovations in the Begg technique had a profound impact on Dr Jayade.

That's how the journey of 'Refined Begg, started.

Dr Jayade, Dr. Girish Karandikar (who had his advanced training in Australia under Dr. Milton Sims and their group) and Dr. Jyothindra Kumar joined hands to introduce Begg's refinements in India. The trio conducted numerous courses in North, Central and South India.

#### Ideal & Idol...

Dr Jayade gives the whole credit to Late Dr. Prem Prakash who was an exceptionally good teacher, a thorough gentleman and an excellent clinician (who could make





bands on all the teeth, weld the attachments, cement the bands and finish the strap-up in one and a quarter hours time). He was the person who wouldn't hold back anything and was very honest. If he didn't know a certain thing, he had no qualms in admitting it. He was a genuine role model for Dr. Jayade.

#### The 'Teacher', The 'Author'...

Dr Jayade feels hesitant to be tagged as 'Teacher of Teachers'. He is of the opinion that such titles should be reserved for eminent teachers like Dr. Burstone. However, he is very happy of the fact that some of his students are doing exceedingly well in their chosen

fields. To name a few, Dr. H.S. Diwakar (USA) has been invited for Moyer's symposium; Dr. Meenakshi (USA) is a speaker for A.A.O. 2024; Dr. Sleeva Raju (Eluru), Dr. Meghna Vandekar (Navi Mumbai) Dr. Narayana Prasad (Rishikesh) and Dr. Vinay Dua (Chandigarh) are now the Principals of dental colleges across India. Many others are doing very well in teaching or practice.

After publishing several papers in the Journal of Indian Orthodontic Society, and other international journals like Angle's, BJO and AAO, Dr Jayade felt a need to write a textbook on Begg refinements. Thus came up the textbook titled "Refined Begg for Modern times". After a few years, he felt that the students were finding the topic of Orthodontic Biomechanics very dry and intimidating. Hence, he came up with another textbook jointly authored by him and Dr Chetan titled "The Essentials of Orthodontic Bio-mechanics, Basic and applied"

#### The 'IOS' Stint...

He was the Editor of Journal of Indian Orthodontic Society for two terms of two years each, from 1986 – 1989. He also had the honor of becoming the President of IOS in the year 1992. He was the first chairman of IBO in the year 2000. He also had the privilege of being the Chairman of the scientific sessions committee for the 1st World Orthodontic Conference held in New Delhi in the year 1997.

#### His Words of Wisdom...

"More than anything else, it is important to be a good human being. One must have the humane approach and empathy for those who are less fortunate. Money is surely important and we all work to earn money, but it shouldn't be the ultimate aim of life. There are more important things like personal life, physical and mental health, family, friends and society in which we live. One shouldn't be arrogant and proud of any materialistic thing. If you want to feel proud, the pride should be for our nation, its culture and heritage.

"I also have a huge concern for the environment. We all should improve it to the best of our abilities and should never think of harming it.

"Moderation in everything is important – whether it is work, diet, habits, sleep or exercise. One should never fall into the extremes. "And always remember the opening lines from the Bhagavad-Gita, which I have quoted at the beginning of this interview. They have been the guiding light for me. They will certainly guide you also."














#### Words of Wisdom...

Having our main practice at home was a big help in looking after the kids. This was further helped that we were a joint family with the grandparents helping looking after the family. However, it was certainly a strain on Asha as she was shuttling between our kids and my parents. She however did both her jobs as an orthodontist and as a mother and daughter- in-law perfectly.







His areas of interest include- Customized orthodontic appliances including Clear Aligners, TADs, lasers, fixed bite jumping appliances, and selfligation brackets.






Hands-on workshop on wire bending session — "Round Edge: Start To Finish" by Dr Elbe Peter, Dr Vinaya S Pai and Dr Manjunath Hegde was organized by the Department of Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopaedics, Bangalore Institute of Dental Sciences in association with Banglore orthodontic study group and Indian Orthodontic Society.

The programme was held on the 17th and 18th of April 2024, in the auditorium of Banglore Institute of Dental Sciences and Hospital. The audience were addressed by The Principal, Dr. Vinaya.S.Pai. She

briefed the audience about the importance of wire bending to achieve results customized to individual patients and their unique smiles. Wire bending is said to be one of the core must-have skills of an orthodontist. Consistent practice makes perfect so the earlier an orthodontist-in -training is taught this art, the better he gets.

Dr. Elbe Peter gave a talk on the Evolution of Edgewise technique and arch forms followed by a demo and hands-on on first-order, second-order, third order and most commonly used loops in orthodontics T loop, T spring, Foot loop, Tear drop loop, double-key hole loop, utility arch and K-SIR loop.




