The 'Humble Human' of Hyderabad!

Childhood Days

Dr. Gandikota ChandraSekhar, fondly known as 'G.C.', born in the year 1962, completed his primary education in villages of Chittoor and Kadapa district (Andhra Pradesh). His father, Late G. Gurumurthy, was a renowned Professor at Sri Venkateswara University, Tirupati. He did his schooling from Nehru Municipal high school in Telugu Medium and Intermediate in SV Junior College in Tirupati in year 1978

The Dentistry Debut

Dr. G.C. always wanted to pursue Medicine as a mainstream but he was destined to do Dentistry somehow. He completed both his BDS (1978 - 1983) and MDS in Orthodontics (1987 - 1990) from prestigious Government Dental College & Hospital, Hyderabad; after securing First rank in combined AP State PG Entrance Exam in year 1987. He was guided by Dr. B. Seshadri, Dr. A.S. Narayana and finally Dr. C.P. Rao in his post - graduation.

Family Life

He got married on the Valentine Day of the year 1992 to Mrs. Sucharita who did post - graduation in Law. Blessed with a son, Aakash, who has a degree in Mass Communication and daughter, Akshara, who has completed her BDS from Sri Ramachandra Dental College, Chennai and is pursuing her Masters in Oral Health Sciences from Temple University, Philadelphia (USA)

Credentials

His teaching experience started from year 1990 and he worked at

various places like Bidar, Raichur, Kalaburagi, Khammam etc. and now from past thirteen years, he is the Professor & Head, Department of Orthodontics at Panineeya Dental College & Hospital, Hyderabad. He also worked as Principal of HKE's SN Dental College, Gulbarga for



two years (2004 - 05). Simultaneously, he developed his own private Practice at Himayatnagar & Ameerpet (Hyderabad) from 1991 and completed 32 years of successful dental practice.

His Role Models

Very few people were aware of Dental Education in Late '70s and he came to know about Dentistry through his close relative, Dr. A. Jayakumar, a senior Periodontist from Hyderabad; who was working in Tirupati then. He has always been his friend, mentor and guide.

Contributions & Achievements in IOS

Hyderabad hosted National Orthodontic conferences in the years 1978 and 1993 and GDCH Hyderabad was the only college having MDS course with 2 seats then. Thanks to a number of private dental colleges which started in '90s and around the year 2000. A dire need for a conglomeration of Orthodontists in Hyderabad resulted in the formation of the Hyderabad Orthodontic Study Group which later became Andhra Pradesh Orthodontic Study Group (APOSG). Dr.G.C., as its founder secretary / convener, continued till he became the President of I.O.S. in year 2016.

All the Orthodontic activities of the dental colleges came under one roof and APOSG bagged a consolation prize in year 2009 and was awarded the Best Study Group in the year 2010 and 2011. Dr. G.C. visited and attended all study groups' programs and went on to become



the Organizing Secretary of Golden Jubilee Indian Orthodontic Conference held at Hyderabad in year 2015.

Dr. K. Sathish Reddy, Vice President D.C.I., was the then Chairman of this conference. Under his chairmanship, everyone worked hard for its success and he was there in the driver's seat while the committee members contributed on a personal level and with their goodwill, hard work & personal





involvement; the conference committee cut down on a lot of expenses and were able to refund two thousand rupees to all the delegates. After the successful conference, we were able to hand over a handsome amount of sixty five lac rupees to the society. "It was something which never happened before!" (smiles confidently).

All the Invited Speakers from India and abroad were given incentives and for all the overseas speakers, the registration charges were waived off & were also provided with accommodation. There was no agency

involved in airport transfers but our members stayed overnight at the airport to receive the delegates. More than two thousand delegates attended 50th IOC, a record number in 2015. Due to floods in Chennai at the same time, the committee refunded the entire amount to the delegates who couldn't make it to

G.C. has always won every IOS election and was elected into the Executive Committee in Indian Orthodontic Society five times from the year 2009. He served as Honorary Secretary & chief convener of



Society in year 2021. He attended almost all conferences since 1987 and attended eight MYCs. He is an active member of AAO and WFO. He was a retired member of Round Table India, Member of 41ers association of India and Member of Grand Lodge of India - Lodge Morland No. 25.

I am into practice since 33 years now and still going strong. We need not worry about general practitioners doing aligners. Majority of the patients come back to us, the orthodontists. The session was moderated by Dr.Sangeetha Duraisamy and the webinar was well attended by more than 150 participants across the country.






