# Dr. U.S. Krishna Nayak

December 16,1961-December 4,2024

December 4, 2024, marks an irreparable loss for the Indian Orthodontic Society (IOS) and the field of dentistru. Dr. U. S. Krishna Nayak, Professor and Principal of A. B. Shetty Memorial Institute of Dental Sciences (ABSMIDS), passed away at the age of 63, leaving behind an indelible legacy of academic excellence, leadership, and humanitu.

Born on December 16, 1961, Dr. Krishna Nayak was the son of one of Mangalore's pioneering dentists, Dr. U. S. Mohandas Nayak, and Indira M. Nayak. An alumnus of St. Aloysius High School and College, he completed his BDS in 1982 and MDS in 1985 from the College of Dental Surgery. Manipal.

Dr. Nayak began his illustrious career as a teacher in orthodontics at ABSMIDS, rising through the ranks to serve as Professor & HOD and Principal. Known for his approachable nature, he was deeply admired by his students and colleagues, earning the affectionate title of "BOSS" from the many postgraduates he mentored.

A Life of Accomplishments

- Celebrated Professional: Dr. Krishna Nayak was the youngest President of the Indian Orthodontic Society (IOS) at the age of 38 (1999-2000). He was honored with the IOS Lifetime Achievement Award in 2024. Dr Keki Mistry Scroll of Honour (2021) and Dr A V Arun Outstanding Professor award (2014)
- · Academic Excellence: Guided over 300 postgraduate students, many of whom are now esteemed professionals and active IOS members.
- · Awards and Recognition: His accolades include the Karnataka State Rajyothsava Award (2003), Famdent Excellence in Dentistry Award (2016), and The Best Dental Administrator Award at the World Dental Conference (2019, Malaysia). Most recently, in 2024, he was named among the '20 Most Prominent Principals in Higher Education.


'Inspiring Humanitarian

Dr Daksha Chitre was the better half of an equally illustrious Maxillo-Facial Surgeon, Dr A. P. Chitre. She was the Past President of Maharashtra State Branch of The Indian Dental Association and a proud Alumnus of the Nair Hospital Dental College, Mumbai. She taught Orthodontics with distinction alongside Dr HS Shaikh during the 1960s & 1970s at the Govt Dental College & Hospital, Mumbai.

An educationist to the core, she was the former Principal of the Terna Dental College & Hospital, Navi Mumbai. Dr Daksha Chitre was a genteel, warm person who commanded respect as a teacher and a successful private practitioner. She was instrumental in the Dr HS Shaikh Foundation getting the IOS to initiate the Oration in Sir's name at the IOS PG Students' Convention in 2009-10.

Our condolences go out to Dr A. P. Chitre and their daughter, Dr. Aparna and other family members.


# 2nd IOS Executive Committee Meeting (2024-25)

## A Smile: A Transformative Journey Through Orthodontic Treatment

The treatment started in July 2021 and concluded in March 2022, taking just 8 months to achieve remarkable results. Seema was dedicated throughout her treatment, with excellent compliance. The aligners worked effectively to tip and extrude her teeth as needed, and the anterior attachments played a key role in developing an improved smile arc. The final results showed no need for refinements, and the root paralleling was perfect.

## FACILILTATION OF RESEARCH COLLABORATION BY INDIAN GOVERNMENT

The Indian government has been taking various measures to progress research and development in universities, colleges, and research institutions across India. The Anusandhan National Research Foundation (ANRF) has been established with Anusandhan National Research Foundation (ANRF) 2023 Act (previously SERB). Our dental institutions should be aware of these facilities and get benefitted. This forum has around 16 research grants including the PAIR (Partnerships for Accelerated Innovation and Research) for fostering research across a broader range of institutions wherein institutions with advanced research facilities, the top-tier institutions (which they refer as HUBS) tie up with developing institutions (SPOKES) to promote collaboration through a specific research proposal submitted by the HUB in tandem with the SPOKE. The website (https://serb.gov.in/page/english/research\_grants) gives the HUB and SPOKE institutions list. Many of the HUBs and SPOKES mentioned here have dental institutions under them. The respective institutions can make the best use of this program which facilitates research collaboration.



Practice Management – an acumen to learn and unlearn and keep innovating

The traditional education of a dentist has placed greater emphasis on developing highly competent diagnostician, excellent wire benders, motivated researchers and clinicians and has often left a noticeable void in the area of practice management, fundamental communication, financial, and management skills needed to run high-quality service oriented practices.

In today's day and age good clinical skills alone does not ensure successful practice. Most clinicians will agree that today's environment is more hostile and it is difficult to break into the ever so competitive dental market.

So, would like to share some Dos and Don'ts of Clinical Practice

## Do's Clinical Skills Don'ts

- Learning the Clinical Skills and the most important is to Diagnose the case, not only for Orthodontic treatment planning but having a holistic approach to overall Oral health of the patient. Understanding the Chief Complaint, taking care of that first and then moving ahead explaining the Bite problems and giving a sensible solution.
- No matter how many spectacular advances in orthodontic therapy are made, it will benefit our patients minimally if there is not a concomi-tant improvement in our diagnostic and prognos-tic knowledge.

DO NOT SELL PRODUCTS TO THE PATIENT Rather explain the need and advantages of the treatment and give a genuine advice. Your consultation should proceed towards an informed and conscious decision making of the patient by guiding them with pre and post treatment photographs and results and experience of the previously treated patients which will help them in decision making and building trust upon the orthodontist. - at the end, you need to create Trust with the patient, so that they can handover themselves to your treatment complete faith.



Here the entire team comes in action starting from the moment when patient enters your clinic till the time he/she leaves, every single step counts like how the patient is greeted welcomed and left with an easy comfortable experience.

#### **Patient Experience** Don'ts

- · Inform the patient well and in a simple explanation, detailed description of steps of treatment and complete payment information
- · Use modern era of Digitalisation to explain details to the patient, animated videos, Pre & Post treatment photographs.
- · Converse well about the progress of the treatment with the patient.
- · Use Continuous reminder with the help of messages and WhatsApp medium, by sending them patient care charts and videos, how to take care of your teeth by cleaning and flossing, what to eat what not to, reminders to wear elastics and aligners.
- · Do not use too many Scientific abbreviation and terms more in front of patient, try to use simple easy to understand language to make patient comfortable.
- · Do not be in hurry to treat and grab the patient, as patients can always sense and feel the detachment.
- Do no get influenced with patient demands (eg: when the patients says I just want front 6 teeth correcection and remaining everything is ok with me) - here you are in the shoes of orthodontist and need to act like one.

Incorporating technology such as practice management software can help automate processes, improve communication, and simplify the scheduling process. Soft skill management is important which includes how you convey your message by not being rude or overpolite but firm with your treatment strategies with which the patient is convinced with your treatment plan

#### **Marketing** Do's Don'ts

- Keep yourselves updated with the newer trends in Orthodontics and Dentistry as a whole. At the end of the day, you are a Dentist and then an Orthodontic specialist. It's not important for you to attain all the skills, but you need to know the intricacies and details of all the possible Dental treatments, to delegate to other specialty. At the end the patient has come to you and it's your trust and duty to provide best possible solution.
- · Do not market yourself extensively until you make your basics right.
- · Good Clinical Environment, well educated, courteous subordinate staff, well informed para staff (who understand dental treatments and the complications) and a good record keeping strategies.





#### HOLIDAYS AND YOUR TEETH-Hola holidays!



And so begins the holiday-ing!

Did you know that about 56.06 percent of people travel, on an average during Christmas time every year!

Here are some easy hacks to keep your teeth healthy and fit, making the trip even more enjoyable:

- 1. Make sure your dentist knows about the trip, in case any wisdom tooth/pain in any tooth needs attention
- 2. Please make sure you inform your orthodontist of any wire/bracket/appliance breakages before you start with the trip, while on the trip too
- 3. There's never an escape from extra oral, removable appliances or aligners while travelling, make sure you carry them for yourself or your child and comply with the treatment
- 4. Don't forget to carry your brush-paste-floss combo for the trip 5. If you are relying on the accommodation place to arrange it for you, advisable to use and throw them after your stay
- 6. Do not share your brush with anyone
- 7. Rinse and gargle your teeth every-time you indulge into sweet delicacies
- 8. Make sure you carry an extra storage box for your aligners/retainers

Dental hygiene and routine has nothing to do with your travel plans. What we mean here is that teeth need to be kept clean, whether at home or away.

### BABY TEETHING TIPS - WHAT PARENTS MUST KNOW?



Teething is simple terms is the process of milk teeth erupting in your child's mouth, from 6 months of age. It is an important milestone in your child's growing period, though quite often painful and uneasy for both the child and the parent.

#### **HOW TO IDENTIFY TEETHING HAS STARTED?**

- 1. Your child is six months or older, one/two gum swelling is noticed in the lower front region
- 2. Frequent fever, rashes, headaches, stomach upset, irritable, not feeding well
- 3. Excessive drooling, biting on objects and toys



- 1. Understand this is a normal pattern and don't panic, instead work on making the process easy and soothing for your child
- 2. Over the top pain killers are advisable, make sure you ask your pediatrician for the correct dosage
- 3. Use teething rings/soothers after reading all the instructions given, especially the cooling temperature and cleaning. These help to soothe the sore gums and distract the child from pain 4. Give them a freshly cut piece of apple, cucumber or carrot to try biting on
- 5. Gently rubbing the gums with a cool gauze piece is also helpful

#### **DO NOT EVER**

- 1. Tie soother/teething ring across your child's neck, this can be a potential choking hazard
- 2. Never apply honey/glycerine around the gums and put the child to sleep

It is also important for you to understand that each child is different and thus, the teething cycle will also not be the same. What remains the same is your unconditional love and warmth towards your child during this phase!

### The orthodontic hacks and tricks

1.Bond both first and second molars in case of high anchorage needs.

2.Cinching vertically in upper arch and in lowers cinching lingually distal to terminal molars for better compliance and outcome.

3.Incorporating closing loops to space closure in cases with high chances of loss of vertical dimensions.

4. Making composite attachments in absence of lingual buttons.

5.Using both facial and lingual attachment on exposed impacted tooth to apply dual traction forces.

6.Refrigerating the HANT wires or making the patient drink cold water to activate the wire.


7.Bite raising over molars and premolars both to reduce the wedging effect.

8.Pain assessment using ordinal scale to prescribe relevant medicines from the start of the treatment to make orthodontic treatment a pleasurable experience.

9.Relaxing music during appointment to use audio analgesia to improve patient compliance.

10.Display of mid treatment photographs and scans to the patients to generate a positive self perception both towards self and the treatment by the patient.

Good communication skills and a friendly doctor patient relationship is the prime factor for the success of treatment
